The students were welcomed by John Rushworth Head of Headways Sixth Form Centre. They also met some of the tutors and enjoyed a typical 'A' level lesson.

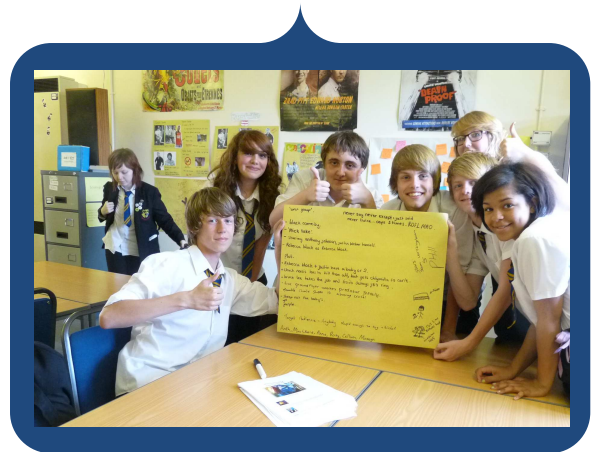
